Dear Church, two weeks ago, I issued a statement in response to executive orders on immigration. There are many executive orders to be concerned about but one that has sparked fear in our communities. The administration has rolled back guidance to immigration authorities in protected areas such as places of worship, schools, and hospitals...We will continue to speak out against harmful policies and in support of our marginalized neighbors.

Before the change in administration, the ELCA's AMMPARO program has focused on broad outreach and full engagement with those we are called to support through this ministry. We have reached out to immigrants, Lutheran congregations and members, global synod companions, and ecumenical and interreligious partners to help them better understand the changes signaled during this administration's campaign.

ELCA advocacy staff have accompanied Lutheran members to Capitol Hill in recent weeks to raise this topic with elected representatives, highlighting how fear is keeping people from attending worship, accessing health care, or going to school.

We are supporting Lutheran Services of America, Global Refuge, and other Lutheran partner organizations directly affected by executive orders and named in a tweet on X several weeks ago regarding government funding to Lutheran organizations.

Recently, the ELCA along with several ecumenical and interreligious partners convened a summit to join our voices in speaking out against these actions. I will continue to speak out on behalf of the ELCA and as your presiding bishop when policies and political rhetoric threaten the lifeblood of our calling to mission and ministry in God s world.
